

ALTERNATIVE SUPPORT OPTIONS FOR CLIENTS

If a client is not eligible for Birth for Humankind support or not able to be matched with a Birth for Humankind doula, below are some alternative options for clients to access continuity of support – from a doula, student doula, or student midwife. Doulas and student doulas may charge a fee (often lower for student doulas). Student midwives offer a free service.

Note: Birth for Humankind has no formal affiliation with any of the below services and therefore cannot provide specific information about them or their members/students.

Note: these services will likely not have the capacity to provide an interpreter. Student midwives attend visits in hospital and could be matched with clients who do not share a language as hospital interpreters will be used. The client would need to have basic English for communication with a student midwife.

Mother Moon

- This is a free service.
- Each application is considered individually and matched on a case-by-case basis.
- With compassion and care, Mother Moon student doulas offer:
 - Three antenatal sessions.
 - On-call availability from 38-42 weeks.
 - Two postpartum visits.
